Tonight's news and reminders.


- Greetings everyone!!! I hope you all had a great week! Thank you, Richard, for filling in for Lance last week.

- Seasonal Activities Calendar – The most recent version is on the website. A few copies are on the table. When changes are made, they will be highlighted in yellow.
- Announcements – These have been added to the website and will no longer be sent out.
- Rehearsal Notes – Teresa’s rehearsal notes have also been added to the website. Please note that these are cumulative and will “grow” from week to week, so if you miss a week, you can still get the update. They will no longer be sent out.
- DVDs/CDs – If any of you ordered a DVD or CD of the Holiday 2024 program, see Ayuko Siegel. If you ordered it, you must pay for it.
- Concert Program – There were extra programs left from the Spring 2024 and Holiday 2025 Concerts which are available.
- Another topic that comes up quite frequently is fragrances. Because of allergies, we urge you to be “fragrance-free” on rehearsal nights, but this does not mean deodorant-free!
- Introduce Lance – Just a reminder that Lance, our “fearless leader” starts promptly at 7:00 p.m. with warm-ups and singing. As a courtesy to those around you, please do not talk or hum along (even quietly) when Lance is working with another section. It’s very distracting, and you’ll get your turn! Besides, you might learn something!
- One director – Another issue is all of the “wanna be” directors we have. Counting out loud, tapping your feet, directing with your hands, etc. These are all distractions to those around you...
- Attendance Sign-In – Be sure to sign in on the attendance sheets. We are allowed 3 missed rehearsals this season, including the large Saturday sectional rehearsals.
